PN Pre-Entrance Test Information

What test does Lex La-Ray administer as the PN Entrance test?

- Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Version V by Assessment Technology Institute
- It is an admission assessment exam that provides test scores in 4 major categories, which aids in the class selection process.

What are the categories?

- **English and Language Usage:** Grammar, word meaning, spelling, punctuation, structure
 - It is 34 items with 34 minutes allotted
- **Reading Comprehension:** paragraph, passage and informational source comprehension
 - It is 48 items with 58 minutes allotted
- **Science:** Scientific reasoning, human body science, life science, earth and physical science
 - It is 54 items with 66 minutes allotted
- **Math:** Basic: numbers and operations, measurements, data interpretation, algebraic applications **No calculators are allowed.**
 - It is 34 items with 51 minutes allotted

How can I make my pre-entrance testing a success?

- Read, Read, Read: this will help with the English Language portion of the test. Read newspapers, magazines, books, work crossword puzzles
- ❖ Basic Math & Science Course offered at Tech Center is highly recommended
 - You may have had algebra in school or often work with money and numbers, but you have probably use a calculator. You may have forgotten the basic principles of computation. Especially with fractions and decimals.
 - Get on line for science and look up the different areas.
 - Get a nurses entrance test book from Amazon.com, Barnes and Nobles or any place you can buy books.
