More about Building Trades...

The Building Trades program is designed for students interested in the building trades field and is nationally certified by the Associated General Contractors.

Building Trades and Carpentry make up one of the largest skill crafts in the building industry. Specialized workers have developed many customized skills in related fields.

Students receive training in rough framing, finishing, drywall application, cabinet making, finish trim, concrete finishing, painting, ceramic tile, plumbing and electrical wiring.

APPRENTICESHIP

Construction Apprenticeship is available through the Building Trades Program. A Carpentry Certificate also earns advanced rank and pay in the military.

ARTICULATED CREDIT

After successfully completing the Building Trades program, you may attend State Fair Community College of Sedalia and receive advanced credit for classes already taken at Lex La-Ray Technical Center.

Students who complete one year with a B average at Lex La-Ray Technical Center may apply for up to 30 semester hours of credit to State Fair Community College toward an Associate of Science degree.

Secondary Admissions Policy:

1. Application with parent signature
2. Essay
3. Student Agreement/Scholarship form
4. Completion of necessary credits at Home School
5. GPA of 2.0 or higher
6. Personal Plan of Study
7. Attendance of 90% or better

Adult/Post Secondary Admissions Policy:

1. Application
2. Non-Refundable Application fee of \$25.00
3. Copies of transcript (or GED certificate) from all institutions previously attended
4. Interview with Lex La-Ray Technical Center Staff
5. 10th grade or higher reading, writing, and math skills - placement exam may be given*
6. 18 years of age or signed Parental Release Form on file with LLRTC
7. Current on all state required immunizations; records must be submitted with an application

*If the applicant did not graduate from a Missouri Public School, accredited private high school, or receive a GED Certificate, a placement exam will be administered at no cost to the applicant. A passing score is required for admittance.

Refund Policy for Adult Students, Post-Secondary (Non-Practical Nursing):

Refunds are calculated on the following schedule:

1. Withdrawal/dismissal prior to the beginning of the semester - full refund of paid tuition and fees (not including application fee) less a \$100.00 Administrative Fee.
2. Withdrawal/dismissal prior to the completion of the second week of the semester - 50% of paid tuition
3. Withdrawal/dismissal prior to the completion of the fourth week of the semester - 25% of paid tuition
4. Withdrawal/dismissal after the fourth week of the semester - No refund
5. Application fee is not refundable. Student activity fees, organization dues, shop fees, books and supplies are non-refundable after the first day of class.

The school refund policy is applicable to all non-practical nursing adult students who execute a complete withdrawal or are dismissed from course work during an academic year. The student's withdrawal/dismissal date is the last day of attendance.
